# Movie leaked online before release

## ◆ Vijay Devarakonda's film goes Jaggubhai way ◆ Assns want govt to curb piracy

Chennai, Nov 14:

Call it a repeat of *Jaggubhai*. But this time in Telugu film industry. Vijay Devarakonda starrer *Taxiwala* slated for release this weekend has made it to internet now. The whole movie has been illegally uploaded in torrent. It has shocked the entire film fraternity in Andhra Pradesh.

An agitated Vijay Devarakonda, said, 'It was jolt, a bolt from the blue. We didn't know what to do. We decided to not talk much about it because the more we speak about online piracy the more people search and find the illicit links. Until the government clamps down heavily on piracy, I feel the best way to combat the menace is to appeal to fans not to watch in piracy.'

According to a leading website, the full movie has been leaked online for 'free downloading' even before its release. Apparently, a group of miscreants leaked an 'unfinished' copy of *Taxiwala* some time ago and the same links are going viral now.

Piracy is one of the biggest challenges facing the film industry today. Recently, *Sarkar* was leaked online within a day of its release and this took a toll on its collections. Similarly *Thugs Of Hindostan* too fell prey to piracy within hours of hitting the screens.

According to reports, India's film industry, said to be the largest globally with some 1,000 movies produced each year, earns around \$2 billion from legitimate sources such as screening at theatres, home videos and TV rights. But with \$2.7 billion, piracy earns 35 per cent more, and a way out has proved elusive.'



Samaran, an industry tracker, says, 'Thanks to broadband connections, people would find it much easier to watch a movie on their laptop than travel to far off theatres. And ticket rates are high. Hence people prefer to watch in mobile phones and laptops. There is need for a collective, structured, scientific, multi-pronged and proactive approach to combat piracy.'

In most cases, an individual

records with a camcorder or high-quality mobile camera in a low-light setting of a cinema theatre, or from the projector room on the day of release. Though technology is available to find out from which theatre, a movie is pirated, it is difficult to prevent them. Tamil Film Producers Council have blacklisted theatres where such crimes took place in the past. They have even asked theatre owners to install cameras inside the cinema hall to keep a watch on those who try to catch a movie in his mobile phone, he added.

Remember in 2010, Sarathkumar starrer *Jaggubhai*, directed by K S Ravikumar, made it to internet much before its theatrical release. The copy was reportedly leaked from post-production studio. Many wondered how the copy leaked from the lab amidst such security.

## Governor to be given 'salt water' reception

Chidambaram, Nov 14:

Around 20,000 people carrying pots filled with salt water will receive Governor Banwarilal Purohit during his visit to attend the graduation day ceremony of Annamalai University 25 November.

Prior to that, the residents of the town will besiege Chidambaram railway station, seeking various demands including drinking water. The protest is organised by

Chidambaram Merchants Association and Kollidam Checkdam Group. The merchants association president Murugappan, secretary Sathish Kumar, Kollidam group coordinators Shanmugam and Senguttuvan said they will be protesting to get the attention of the State government through the Governor. They said their protest is against the non-construction of Kollidam checkdam for a long period, the issue of salt water intrusion in their villages and against trains not halting at Chidambaram station.

## Destroy Nedumaran's book on Eelam: HC

Chennai, Nov 14:

The Madras High Court has ordered the State Government to destroy all the copies of 'Tamizh Eelam Sivakiradhu' book authored by Tamil Desiya Iyakkam leader Pazha Nedumaran.

Nedumaran was arrested in 2002 for writing the book in support of Tamizh Eelam. The copies that

were circulated at that time were seized. The government withdrew the case in 2006, after which he was relieved from the case.

Following this, Nedumaran filed a petition at the court seeking the return of the copies seized from him. The petition came for hearing before justice M V Muralidharan.

The advocate who appeared on behalf of Nedumaran argued that the case has been withdrawn and the copies have to be exported to other

countries. The government in its response said that releasing the copies in public forum will lead to law and order problem as it is against the Indian army and has made many accusations against the former Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi.

After hearing the argument from both sides, Justice Muralidharan dismissed the petition and asked the government to take necessary action to destroy all the copies.

## Sabarimala: All-party meet tomorrow

Thiruvananthapuram, Nov 14:

Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan has called for an all-party meet tomorrow to discuss Supreme Court's decision on Tuesday to hear review petitions against its judgment on women's entry into Sabarimala temple. The Chief Minister will discuss future course of action that needs to be taken by the State

government in this issue keeping the welfare of the people at large.

Earlier, opposition parties and stakeholders in Sabarimala temple in Kerala welcomed Supreme Court's decision and demanded that women in the age group between 10 and 50 shouldn't be allowed inside the temple during the Mandala Makaravillakku pilgrim season, starting 17 November.

## Rajapaksa...

an election commission member Ratnajeevan Hoole, on Monday dragged Sirisena to the Supreme Court, challenging his decision by filing fundamental rights petitions against the move, which they said violated the Constitution.

Sirisena dissolved Parliament last week, almost 20 months before its term was to end, and ordered snap election on January 5, plunging the country's into an unprecedented political and constitutional crises.

Wickremesinghe has maintained that his sacking by Sirisena was unconstitutional and illegal and he was still the prime minister.

Wickremesinghe had demanded that Parliament be convened to hold a vote among the lawmakers to decide who enjoyed majority support in Parliament to be the Prime Minister.

Sirisena on Sunday stoutly defended his move to dissolve Parliament, saying it was taken to prevent clashes among rival lawmakers. He said there were reports that politicians would clash during the floor test, which was due on 14 November.

Rajapaksa, 72, who ruled Lanka for a nearly decades from 2005, was unexpectedly defeated by his deputy Sirisena in the presidential election held in January 2015 with the support from Wickremesinghe's UNP.

However, the power-sharing arrangement between Sirisena and Wickremesinghe became increasingly tenuous on several policy matters, especially on issues like the economy and security. And subsequently, Sirisena abruptly ousted Wickremesinghe and replaced him with Rajapaksa.
