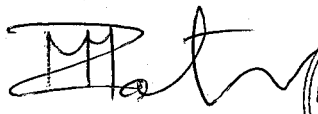

Chennai sets Sept 30 deadline for monsoon works

Chennai, Aug 13: The Greater Chennai Corporation has set September 30 as the deadline to complete monsoon-preparedness works across the city, including desilting 1,300 km of stormwater drains and cleaning 1.10 lakh silt catch pits, as it steps up preparations for the northeast monsoon and possible intense rainfall linked to El Nino.

Joint Commissioner (Works) C. Saravanan on Wednesday inspected the first mock drill to check the operational readiness of vehicles, heavy machinery, pumps and rescue equipment at Ripon Buildings. Similar checks were carried out at all zonal and ward offices.

The Corporation has around 3,000 km of stormwater drains, of which desilting is under way along nearly 1,300 km. The work is being monitored using drones and GPS. Silt is also being removed from 1,10,082 catch pits to ensure the free flow of rainwater.

The civic body currently has around 700 pumps and machines and has contracted another 150 machines on a rental basis for the monsoon, including tractor-mounted 100 HP pumps. Pumps ranging from 5 HP to 150 HP will be deployed depending on flooding conditions.

The equipment being kept ready includes two amphibian machines, three mini-amphibians, six robotic multipurpose excavators, three amphibious excavators, seven recycler vehicles, 15 hydraulic tree-cutting machines, 10 truck-mounted cranes, five hydraulic ladders, six front-end loaders, seven hydraulic excavators and 60 skid-steer loaders.

High-capacity pumps will be



positioned to drain water from severely low-lying areas. Additional 80 HP to 100 HP pumps and tractor-operated pumps will also be hired depending on requirements.

To ensure that equipment remains operational, Rs 5 lakh has been allotted to each ward to carry out minor repairs and other immediate pre-monsoon requirements. Separately, around Rs 1 crore has been allocated to each zone for repairing temporary road depressions and potholes.

Desilting is also under way in the city's waterways. The Corporation's 44 waterways and major channels and rivers maintained by the Water Resources Department, including the Cooum, Adyar, Buckingham Canal, Otteri Nullah, Virugambakkam Canal and Veerangal Odai, are being taken up as part of the preparations. Officials have been instructed to ensure that works being carried out by the Corporation, Chennai Metrowater, electricity department and other agencies are expedited and completed by September 30. Inter-departmental coordination meetings are being held every Tuesday to address issues including

road-cutting works.

Special attention is being given to areas that have experienced flooding during previous monsoons. Officials said 383 waterlogging-prone locations were identified during Cyclone Michaung in 2023. Permanent stormwater drain works have been completed at some locations, while pumps are being planned as an interim measure at others. Joint field inspections are also being carried out at flood-prone areas such as Velachery, Pallikarainai and Okkiyam Maduvu by the Corporation, Water Resources Department, Chennai Metro Rail and Highways Department.

Saravanan said the preparations were being drawn up based on the city's experience during the 2015, 2023 and 2025 monsoons. The civic body was also preparing for extreme rainfall events, including the possibility of cloudburst-like conditions, he said.

The government is expected to issue guidelines for the public on precautions to be followed during extreme rainfall events, officials said.



Chennai Port boosts Hyderabad trade connectivity

Chennai, Aug.13:

A train service carrying export and import goods between Hyderabad and Chennai Port has restarted, giving businesses in Hyderabad and the surrounding region a quicker, cheaper way to move their cargo to the coast for shipping abroad.

The first train pulled in on 11 August, carrying 46 containers. Chennai Port Authority (ChPA) Chairperson Sachin S.

Kurve flagged off the unloading, joined by CONCOR's Area Head South, Gayatri, who called stronger rail links to Hyderabad key to the port's competitiveness. The service runs between the inland container depot at Sanathnagar, Hyderabad (CSTN) and Chennai Port (CITPL), and is operated by CONCOR in partnership with shipping line OOCL.

Officials say the route

gives Far East-bound cargo a viable alternative to West Coast gateways, with comparable logistics costs and transit times cut by up to seven days. Chennai's links to Port Klang, Singapore, China and Southeast Asia also open options for west-bound shipments via established transshipment hubs.

To build on this, ChPA has set up a dedicated Rail Connectivity Cell

to work with CONCOR, other terminal operators and shipping lines, with outreach underway in Hyderabad, Pollachi, Mysore and other markets to shift more cargo onto rail.

The port has also formed a Trade Facilitation Cell coordinating with Customs, terminals, shipping lines and rail operators on digitisation and connectivity, and is exploring incentives for rail-linked cargo.

Alongside other recent schemes, the moves underline ChPA's push on connectivity, cargo growth and ease of doing business.
